Plains of secs. 7, 11, 13 and 18 marked with 4 notches on S and 2 notches on N. edge; dig pits $18 \times 18 \times 1$ 1/2 in. in each sec. 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor.

Land nearly level.

Dirt sandy & drate.

Large brush and grass

North trk. secs. 7 and 12.

Over nearly level land.

Let a granite stone $16 \times 6 \times 3$ in. 11 in. in the ground for 1/4 sec. Cov. marked 1/4 on W. face dig pits. $18 \times 18 \times 1$ 1/2 in. N. and S. of stone 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. base $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cov.
