

Subdivision of T. 21 N., R. 54 E., M.D.M.

Chains.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township contains a variety of land, both valley and mountainous. The soil of the mountainous portion, to-wit: The Southwestern and Central part of township, is 2nd and 3rd rate, mostly 2nd rate; and the valley land is a light sandy loam, nearly all of which can be classed as 1st rate, but will not produce a crop without irrigation.

The mountainous portion is fairly well watered by Mattel and Pedrioli Creeks, and a number of small springs, but do not furnish a sufficient quantity of water for irrigating the arid valley land.

There is some small Juniper timber in the mountainous portion for domestic use only.

There is one settler each in sec. 23 and sec. 34, both of whom have land under cultivation.
