Chains.

for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on N. face; and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor. Pits impracticable.

- 42.00 Top of round hill, 25 ft. high; descend.
- 50.92 Wagon road, Holland's ranch to William's corral, bears N.E. and S.W.
- 51.60 Dry wash, 50 ft. below top of hill, course N.W.; ascend.
- 77.62 Wire fence, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.
- 80.12 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.
- Undergrowth, sage brush, willows, rye and bunch grass.
- No timber.
- Mountainous land, or land covered with dense undergrowth
- 36.75 chains.

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- West bet. secs. 18 and 19.
- Through scattering sage brush,
- 1.06 Center of reef of rocks, bears N.E. and S.W.; descend.
- 5.95 Wire fence, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; leave field.
- 19.75 Ravine, course S.; ascend.
- 22.73 Top of spur, bears N. and S.
- 26.00 Ravine, course S.
- 40.00 Set a granite stone, 15x12x7 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on N. face; and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor. Pits impracticable.
- 41.35 Small ravine, course S.E.; thence ascend steep E. slope of Big Island mountain 600 ft. to
- 70.37 Intersect the Ruby Valley Guide Meridian, 14.00 chs. N. of the cor. of secs. 18 and 19, which is a granite stone 8x7x8 ins. above ground, firmly set; and marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
- At the point of intersection, set a quartz stone, 15x12 x7 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs.
