Chains. May 27, 1906, I begin at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36 on S. bdy. of Tp. heretofore described.

Magnetic Declination 16°20'E.

Thence I run

N. 0° I' W. bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over mountainous land.

27.00 Dry wash, course NW.

33.00 Low spur slopes NW.

35.00 Dry wash, course NW.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 16X12X8 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone 2ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

43.00 Spur slopes NW.

47.00 Enter canyon.

50.00 Bottom of canyon, course NW.

51.70 Begin ascent.

56.00 Spur slopes NW.

63.00 Dry wash, course SW.

64.00 Transvaal road bears NE. and SW.

80.00 Point of spur slopes SW!

Set a basalt stone 18X12X6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36, marked with I notch on S. and E. edges, and raise a mound of stone 2ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

Land mountainous.

Soil sandy and rocky, 3rd. rate.

Scattering sagebrush.

Mountainous land, 80.00 chs.

N. 89° 49' E. on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

40.00 Set a temporary $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

80.10 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp. 5 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36.

Thence I run

S. 89° 51' W. on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Over mountainous land. Ascending.

5.00 High spur slopes N.
