SUPPLEMENTAL FIELD NOTES.

Sir:

In compliance with G. L. O. letter "E" of April 10, 1907. I herewith hand you the additional data necessary to complete the notes of Contract No. 248.

I determined beyond a doubt, that the standard corner of T 12 S. Rgs. 44 and 45 E. is east of the California and Nevada boundary line, as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey, which line is easily traced from the data furnished me by you.

I run the connections to U. S. Location Monuments No. 171, 175, 177, 180, 183 and 184 at the time I made the survey of the various townships, but failed to put same in notes. They are as follows:

From the Cor. of Secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9, T. 12 S., R. 46 E., U. S. L. M. No. 171 bears S. 87° 07' E. 16.23 chs.

From the Cor. of Secs. 8, 9, 16, and 17, T. 12 S., R. 46 E. U. S. L. M. No. 177 bears S. 54° 55' 30" E., 35.87 chs.

From the Cor. of Secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11 T. 12 S. R. 46 E. U. S. L. M. No. 175 bears S. 19° 45' W. 26.36 chs.

From the 1/4 sec. cor. between secs 30 and 31 T. 11 S. R. 46 E., U. S. L. M. No. 180 bears S. 89° 49' 40" W. 10.67 chs.

From the Cor. of Secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, T 11 S. R. 47 E. U. S. L. M. No. 183 bears S. 83° 18' 20" W. 10.35 chs.
