CHAINS

No timber; undergrowth shad scale.

Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Gradual ascent over sandy land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 14x7x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of stone, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 14x12x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec., 5 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

North bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Gradual ascent over sandy land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 12x10x6 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of stone, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x14x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 S., Rs. 49 and 50 E., marked 3 S on NE., 50 E., on SE., 4 S on SW., and 49 E., on NW. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, dig pits, 24x24x12 ins., on each line, N., E. and W., 4 ft. and S. of stone, 8 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 5 ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.
