CHAINS

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x15x5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

72.25 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course E.

Ascend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 20x12x4 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Ascend along broken, rocky and mountainous east slope.

31.00 Rocky spur, projects E.

Descend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x8x6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

63.00 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course E.

Ascend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x10x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 S., Rs. 50 and 51 E., marked 3 S on NE., 51 E., on SE., 4 S on SW., and 50 E on NW., faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Pits impracticable.
