Chains.

North bet. secs. 1 and 6,

Ascending, over rolling, rocky land; through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 18x15x7 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 15x10x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 2 and 3 S., Rs. 51 and $51\frac{1}{2}$ E., marked
 2 S on NE.
 $51\frac{1}{2}$ E on SE.
 3 S. on SW. and
 51 E. on NW. face; with 6 notches on each edge; and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high S. of cor. Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky; 3d rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth sagebrush and greasewood.

Land covered with dense undergrowth 80.00 chs.
