

CHAINS

North bet. secs. 1 and 6

Descending over rolling, gravelly land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x8x5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 1 and 2 S., Rs. 51 and 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., marked

1 S on NE.,

51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. on SE.,

2 S on SW., and

51 E on NW face, with 6 notches on each edge, and

raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling.

Soil, gravelly, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, greasewood and sage brush.

Land, covered with dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.
