Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Ascend abruptly over rocky and mountainous land.

8.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.

Abrupt descent.

40.00 Hollow, 200 ft. deep, course NE.

Set a basalt stone, 15x10x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for
¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ on W. face, and raise a mound of
stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Abrupt ascent.

62.00 Rocky spur, projects NE.

Abrupt descent.

80.00 Set a limestone, 12x8x8 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for
cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1
notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,
1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Descend abruptly over rocky and mountainous land.

9.00 Hollow, 300 ft. deep, course SE.

22.00 Rocky spur, projects SE.
