CHAINS

Land, mountainous and rolling.
 Soil, rocky and granite debris, 3rd. rate.
 No timber.
 Undergrowth, shad scale.
 Mountainous land, or dense undergrowth, on 80.00 chs.

I destroy all corners set on the Mount Diablo Base,
 through R.52 E., which were set on the original survey.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Mount Diablo Base through R.52 E., begins in Railroad Valley on the east and runs west over the Reveille Mountains to Reveille Valley on the west.

The eastern half mile falls in a rolling valley covered with a dense growth of shad scale and grasses, from this valley the line runs over broken and rocky mountainous land with a scattering growth of cedar and pinon timber near the summit of the mountain.

The western half mile falls into a valley covered with a dense growth of shad scale brush and grasses.

There are no springs, settlements or mining claims along this line.
