

CORRECTIVE NOTES OF EAST BOUNDARY OF T.2 N., R.51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.

CHAINS

S. and 1 notch on N. edges, from which

A cedar, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 12° 15' E., 128 lks. dist., marked T 2 N R 52 E S 7 BT.

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 20° W., 66 lks. dist., marked T 2 N R 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 12 BT.

No other trees within limits and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

Note:

This cor. is set 5 lks. south and 3 ft. higher than the bottom of the water course of hollow.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.

Timber, cedar and pinon.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Ascend abruptly over rocky and mountainous land.

14.00 Rocky spur, projects E. Abrupt descent.

27.50 Foot of abrupt descent, bears NW. and SE.

Descend along rocky east slope.

40.00 Set a limestone, 15x10x9 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which

A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 63° 45' W., 170 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 BT.

No other trees within limits and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

62.75 Road in hollow, 150 ft. deep; course E. Ascend.

77.00 Road, bears NW. and SE.

78.08 A distance equal to the length of the W. bdy. of the Tp. Set a basalt stone, 24x12x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 2 and 3 N., R. 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., marked 3 N 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E on NW., 2 N on SW. faces, with 6 notches on N., S. and W. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.
