

SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T.4 N., R.51 E.

CHAINS

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

East, bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Ascend over rocky and mountainous land.

5.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.

Descend.

20.00 Hollow, 75 ft. deep, course NW.

Ascend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x12x6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

69.50 Ridge, bears N. and S.

Abrupt descent.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x7 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-2-35 and 36, marked with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

East, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Descend abruptly over rocky and mountainous land.

4.70 Begin abrupt descent over basalt ledges, bearing NE. and SW.

15.00 Foot of ledges, bearing NE. and SW.

Abrupt descent.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x12x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.
