EAST BOUNDARY OF T.3 N., R.51½ E.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.
No timber.
Mountainous land on 130.80 chs.

September 13, 1909

EAST BOUNDARY OF T.3 N., R.51 E.

May 11: At 7h.56m., a.m., l.m.t., I set off 38°02' N., on lat. arc, 17°42' N., on decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, at the cor. of Tps. 2 and 3 N., Rs. 51 and 51½ E., heretofore described.

Thence I run

North, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Descend abruptly over rocky and mountainous land.

3.50 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend abruptly along steep west slope.

38.85 Ridge, bears E. and W.

Descend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x8x5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

51.50 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend.

73.00 Ridge, bears E. and W.

Abrupt descent.

76.80 Head of hollow, course NE.

Ascend.

80.00 Set a lava stone, 18x10x7 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25-30-31 and 36, marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.
