2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 5-6-31 and 32, marked with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edges and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Ascend over rocky and mountainous land along north slope of ridge, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 12x9x8 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

79.35 Fall 36 lks. N. of the temp. cor. of Tps. 4 and 5 N., Rs. 52 and 53 E., I destroy the temp. cor. and at this point set a basalt stone, 15x10x9 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 4 and 5 N., Rs. 52 and 53 E., marked 5 N on NE., 53 E on SE., 4 N on SW. and 52 E. on NW. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 79.35 chs.
