40.00 I remark $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face of the stone described in the original field notes, and dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of stone, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

80.00 I remark with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edges on the stone described in the original field notes, dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

There is no change of topography on this line.

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

40.00 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. well marked and well set, I dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of stone, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

80.00 I remark with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, the stone described in the original field notes, dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

There is no change of topography on this line.

North bet. secs. 1 and 6

40.00 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., well marked and well set, I dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of stone, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

80.00 I remark with 3 S on NE., 48 E on SE., 4 S on SW., and 47 E on NW. face, with 6 notches on N.S.E. and W. edges, the original stone for cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 S., Rs. 47 and 48 E., dig pits, 24x24x12 ins., on each line, N., E. and W., 4 ft. and S. of stone 8 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth,
