69.00	Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course NW. Ascend.
78.00	Spur, projects NW. Descend over boulders.
80.00	Point for cor. falls on a granite boulder, $3 \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ ft. above ground; I mark a cross(X), at exact point for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked 5 grooves on S. and 1 groove on N. sides of cross, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate. No timber. Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.
	North, bet. secs. 1 and 6. Abrupt descent over mountainous land.
13.00	Head of hollow, course E. Ascend.
25.00	Ridge, bears NW. and SE. Descend.
40.00	Set a basalt stone, $18 \times 10 \times 8$ ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

51.75	Spur, projects E. Descend.
66.00	Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course E. Ascend.
72.20	Spur, projects E. Descend.
79.20	Intersect S. Bdy. of T.7 S., R.42 E., 70.70 chs., S. $89^{\circ}58'E.$, of the cor. of Tps. 7 and 8 S., Rs. 41 and 42 E., heretofore
