

EAST BOUNDARY OF T.7 S., R.43 E.

CHAINS

1906

November 11: At 7h.44m., a.m., l.m.t., I set off 37°15'N., on lat.arc, 17°14'S., on decl.arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, at the cor.of Tps.7 and 8 S., Rs.43 and 44 E., heretofore described.

Thence I run

North, bet.secs.31 and 36.

Ascend over rocky and rolling land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 14x9x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec.cor., marked 1/4 on W.face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft.base, 1 1/2 ft.high, W.of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 12x10x6 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for cor.of secs.25-30-31 and 36, marked with 1 notch on S.and 5 notches on N.edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft.base, 1 1/2 ft.high, W.of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky, 3rd.rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

North, bet.secs.25 and 30.

Ascend over rolling land, through dense undergrowth.

36.00 Road, bears NW.and SE.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x9x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec.cor., marked 1/4 on W.face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft.base, 1 1/2 ft.high, W.of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x7 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor.of secs.19-24-25 and 30, marked with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on N.edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft.high, W.of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky, 3rd.rate.

No timber; undergrowth greasewood.
