

NORTH BOUNDARY OF T.6 S., R.43 E.

CHAINS

R.43 E. S 5 on SE.,
 T.6 S S 6 on SW., and
 S 31 on NW. faces, with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W.
 edges, dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec., 5½ ft. dist.,
 and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
 Land, level.

Soil, sandy, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over level land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a charred pine post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., with marked
 stone, 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S 31
 on N., and 6 on S. faces, dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W.
 of post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 3½ ft.
 base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

87.92 Intersect the Reese River Guide Meridian, 9.03 chs. S. of
 the cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., Rs. 42 and 43 E., heretofore
 described.

Set a basalt stone, 15x9x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for
 closing cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., R. 43 E., marked C C 43 E
 on E., 5 S on N., and 6 S on S. faces, with 6 grooves on
 N., S., and E. faces, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,
 1½ ft. high, E. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

I destroy all marks on the cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., Rs. 42
 and 43 E., that pertain to R. 43 E.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 87.92 chs.
