60.00 Spur, projects E.

Descend.

80.00 Set a limestone, 12x10x8 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 6 and 7 S., Rs. 45 and 46 E., marked 6 S on NE., 46 E on SE., 7 S on SW., and 45 E on NW. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, S. of cor.
