CHAINS

Abrupt descent.

21.00 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course NE.

Ascend.

32.00 Begin abrupt ascent, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 14x10x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

62.50 Spur, projects NE.

Abrupt descent.

70.00 Hollow, 200 ft. deep, course NE.

Abrupt ascent.

75.00 Spur, projects NE.

Descend.

76.75 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course NE.

Ascend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 12x8x7 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Ascend over rocky and mountainous land.

4.00 Rocky spur, projects E.

Descend.

40.00 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course NE.

Set a basalt stone, 12x8x6 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of stone, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
