Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Ascend over mountainous land.

31.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.

Descend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 20x11x7 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

43.00 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend.

70.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.

Descend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x10x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12., marked with 5 notches on S., and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Descend over rocky and mountainous land.

10.30 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course W.

Abrupt ascent.

18.00 Ridge, bears E. and W.

Abrupt descent.
