## CHAINS

1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Descend over mountainous land.

12.50 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend.

14.00 Ridge, bears E. and W.

Descend.

23.75 Hollow, 75 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend.

31.50 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.

Descend.

40.00 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course NW.

Set a basalt stone, 20x9x6 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for

¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ on W. face, and raise a mound of

stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Ascend.

67.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.

Descend.

76.75 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend.

81.00 Ridge, bears E. and W.

Descend.

86.00 Hollow, 75 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend.

88.00 Intersect the First Standard Parallel South, 1.25 chs.

W., of the standard cor. of Tps. 4 S., Rs. 46 and 47 E., which

is a basalt stone, 14x10x6 ins. above ground, marked and

witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
