

NORTH BOUNDARY OF T.6 S., R.47 E.

CHAINS Descend.

39.50 Head of hollow, course SE.

Ascend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x11x9 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on N. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

45.00 Spur, projects S.

Abrupt descent.

57.50 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course S.

Ascend.

62.20 Spur, projects S.

Descend.

71.00 Leave mountainous land, bears NE. and SW.

Gradual descent over sandy land, through dense undergrowth.

79.50 Wash, 50 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course SW.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x12x6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-2-35 and 36, marked with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous, and rolling.

Soil, rocky and sandy, 3rd. rate.

No timber: undergrowth, greasewood and sage.

Mountainous land or dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

East, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over level sandy land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a lava stone, 15x12x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on N. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Intersect W. bdy. of T.6 S., R.48 E., 5.85 chs. S. of the cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., Rs. 47 and 48 E., heretofore described.

Set a lava stone, 15x8x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of Tps. 5 and 6 S., R.47 E., marked 5 S on N.,
