

THIRD STANDARD PARALLEL SOUTH, through RANGE 55 $\frac{1}{2}$  EAST.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The Third Standard Parallel South, through R. 55 $\frac{1}{2}$  E., runs over the Desert Mountains, which is a rough, limestone mountain with steep slopes on E. and W. sides.

The soil is rocky throughout and on the west slope is covered with a dense growth of desert brush.

There is no surface water or timber on this line.

There are no indications of mineral on this line.

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
