GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township lies on the divide between the Death Valley and the Great Basin, the divide is not well defined but the drainage is about equal in each direction. The surface of the township is generally mountainous and rocky, with some undergrowth on the slopes. There is no surface water or timber in this township. There are no indications of mineral in this township. The Nevada-California state boundary line does not run through this township, the nearest point to the bdy., the south west cor. of this township is at least 3 miles distant.

WEST BOUNDARY OF T.10 S., R.47 E.

November 5: At 7h.44m., a.m., l.m.t., I set off 36°58'N. on lat.arc, 15°29'S. on decl.arc, and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of Tps. 10 and 11 S., Rs. 46 and 47 E., which is a basalt stone, 12x10x6 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. Thence I run North, bet. secs. 31 and 36. Descend over mountainous land, through dense undergrowth.
