

WEST BOUNDARY OF T.10 S., R.47 E.

CHAINS

3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

51.00 Ridge, bears E. and W.

Descend.

60.50 Hollow, 50 ft. deep, course W.

Ascend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 14x12x10 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

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North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Ascend over rolling land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/2 on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x10x7 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 S., Rs. 46 and 47 E., marked 9 S on NE., 47 E on SE., 10 S on SW., and 46 E on NW. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, S. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.
