CHAINS

cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling on 46.00 chs.

balance, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth or mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

November 8: At this cor. I set off 16°27'S. on decl. arc, and at 11h.44m., a.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting lat. is 37°08'N.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Ascend over rolling land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x11x4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

87.22 Intersect the 2nd. Standard Parallel South, 7.80 chs. W. of the standard cor. of Tps., 8 S., Rs. 46 and 47 E., which is a basalt stone, 10x6x6 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as returned under Contract No. 251.

Set a basalt stone, 18x12x7 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. to Tps. 9 S., Rs. 46 and 47 E., marked C C 9 S on S., 46 E on W., and 47 E on E. faces, with 6 grooves on S., E. and W. faces, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 87.22 chs.
