GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township is situated at the south east end of the Sarcobatus Flat; the eastern portion is mountainous and rocky and the western portion lies in the flat and the soil is sandy and covered with a dense growth of desert brush.

There is no surface water or timber in this township.

There are some indications of mineral in the south east portion of the township.

WEST BOUNDARY OF T. 9 S., R. 46 E.

November 11: At 7h.44m., a.m., l.m.t. I set off 37°04'N. on lat. arc, 17°14'S. on decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 S., Rs. 45 and 46 E., heretofore described.

Thence I run

North, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Abrupt descent over rocky land, over north east slope of isolated knoll.

10.00 Foot of abrupt descent, bears NW. and SE.

Gradual descent over sandy land, through dense undergrowth in Sarcobatus Flat.
