

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF T.9 S., R.45 E.

This township lies in Sarcobatus Flat and the soil is generally gravelly or sandy, with the exception of a large dry lake which extends into the northwestern portion of the township, the soil of which is mixed with borax.

The entire township is generally covered with a dense growth of desert brush.

There is no surface water or timber in this township.

There are no indications of mineral found in this township.

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Note:

On account of stormy weather I have to abandon this portion of the contract, until the spring of 1907.
