CHAINS

South, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Descend over rocky and rolling land, through dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x7x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 S., Rs. 49 and 50 E., marked 13 S on NE., 50 E on SE., 14 S on SW., and 49 E on NW faces, with 6 notches on each edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber., undergrowth, greasewood.

Dense undergrowth on 80.00 chs.

EAST BOUNDARY OF T.14 S.,R.49 E.

From the cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 S., Rs. 49 and 50 E., I run

South, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Descend over rolling land, through dense undergrowth.

24.25 Road, from Hiko to Bullfrog, bears NE. and SW.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 14x12x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x10x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-67 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.
