 79.00 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course N.
 Abrupt ascent.
 80.00 Set a quartzite stone, 12x9x7 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for
 cor. of secs. 5-6-31 and 32, marked with 5 notches on E. and
 1 notch on W. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,
 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.
 Pits impracticable.
 Land, mountainous.
 Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.
 No timber.
 Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

 West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.
 Ascend over rocky and mountainous land.
 11.00 Spur, projects N.
 Descend.
 14.00 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course N.
 Abrupt ascent.
 23.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.
 Descend.
 32.00 Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course N.
 Ascend.
 35.00 Spur, projects N.
 Descend.
 36.14 Intersect the Nevada-California state boundary line,
 37.40 chs. S. 47°40'E., of Station 96, which is a pine
 post 4 ins. sq., projecting 12 ins. above a stone cairn,
 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, the post marked "C N 96"
 Stations Nos. 95 and 97, on the Nevada-California state
 boundary line can be seen from Station No. 96 and the
 course of this bdy. line from Station No. 96 to Station
 No. 95 is N. 47°40'W. and from Station Station No. 96 to
 Station No. 97, is S. 47°40'E.
 At point of intersection, set a lava stone, 30x15x6 ins.,
 23 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of Tps. 14 and 15 S.,
