

WEST BOUNDARY OF T.13 S., R.48 E.

CHAINS	Abrupt descent.
23.00	Hollow, 300 ft. deep, course W. Abrupt ascent over limestone ledges.
40.00	Point for cor. falls on the smooth surface of the limestone ledges; I cut a cross (X), at exact point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. mark $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. side of cross, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable.
46.00	Rocky spur, projects W. Abrupt descent.
49.00	Hollow, 100 ft. deep, course SW. Abrupt ascent.
50.75	Rocky ridge, bears NE. and SW. Abrupt descent.
58.00	Hollow, 250 ft. deep, course W. Abrupt ascent.
62.30	Rocky ridge, bears NW. and SE. Descend abruptly along steep west slope over basalt ledges.
80.00	Point for cor. falls on the smooth surface of a ledge, sloping west; I cut a cross (X) at exact point for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, mark 5 grooves on S. and 1 groove on N. sides of cross, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable. Land, mountainous. Soil, rock, 4th. rate. No timber, Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.
	North, bet. secs. 1 and 6. Descend abruptly over basalt ledges.
13.00	Hollow, 500 ft. deep, course W. Abrupt ascent over ledges.
40.00	Top of narrow basalt ridge, divide of Bare Mountains, bearing NW. and SE, elevation 6000 ft. above sea level.
