2.35 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course NE.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 18x8x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.

41.34 Intersect the Nevada-California State Boundary line, 20.55 chs., N.  $47^{\circ}40'$  W., of Station No. 96, heretofore described.

Set a basalt stone, 18x12x10 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. Tps. 14 S., Rs. 46 and 47 E., marked C C N. 14 S on N., C on S., 46 E on W., and 47 E on E., faces, with 6 grooves on N., . . . face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.
