

EAST BOUNDARY OF T.11 S., R.48 E.

CHAINS

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Ascend abruptly over rocky and mountainous land,

19.00 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course NE.

abrupt ascent along steep east slope.

30.00 Rocky spur, projects E.

Descend.

34.00 Hollow, 75 ft. deep, course E.

Ascend.

36.25 Rocky spur, projects E.

Abrupt descent.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x10x4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

47.00 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course NW.

Ascend.

54.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.

Abrupt descent.

79.00 Enter bottom of Beatty Wash, a hollow, 250 ft. deep, course W.

Over level bottom of hollow.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x6x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

In bottom of Beatty Wash, over level and sandy land, through dense greasewood brush.

4.50 Leave bottom of wash.

Begin abrupt ascent, bears E. and W.
