

## SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T.10 S., R.44 E.

## CHAINS

Pits impracticable.

80.00 Bottom of hollow, 100 ft. deep, course NE.

Set a basalt stone, 15x13x4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 5-6-31 and 32, marked with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 80.00 chs.

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West, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Ascend abruptly over rocky and mountainous land.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x9x4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ on N. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

66.00 Rocky spur, projects NE.

Abrupt descent.

77.50 Hollow, 200 ft. deep, course N.

Ascend abruptly over slide rock.

78.91 Allowing for convergency.

Set a basalt stone, 18x12x5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 10 and 11 S., Rs. 43 and 44 E., marked 10 S on NE., 44 E on SE., 11 S on SW., and 43 E on NW. face, with 6 notches on each edge, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.

No timber.

Mountainous land on 78.91 chs.
