40.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x10x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on W. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

46.00 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course NE.

Ascend.

77.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.

Abrupt descent.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x8x5 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1-6-7 and 12, marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.
