Chains

40.50 mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.
 50.82 Top of spur from ridge, bears NE. and SW. descend.
 Intersect old closing cor. which is a trachyte
 24x24x20 ins. above ground, firmly set with mound
 of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high E. of corner, being the
 closing cor. of secs. 1 and 6, on the Boundary line of
 the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation and is identically
 the same stone as the 123½ M. stone of said boundary.
 I found the stone plainly marked 123½ M. on W. face,
 PL on S. and CC on top but facing south and PLIR on
 N. face.
