- 40.00 Set a quartz porphyry rock 18x10x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face and raise a mound of stone $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.
- 64.85 Ridge bears E. and W., descend into
- 67.00 Ravine course N.W. ascend to
- 80.00 Ridge bears E. and W.
- 87.00 Ridge bears E and W descend into
- 93.00 Ravine course N. W. ascend to
- 105.00 Ridge bears E and W. descend into
- 114.25 Ravine course N. ascend to
- 120.00 Ridge bears E and W.
- 124.80 Descend steep slope into
- 128.00 Ravine course N.W. ascend slope
- 136.70 Ridge bears E. and W.

- 153.00 Enter rolling hills, continue mountainous.
- 159.50 Forks of road from Denio, Oregon. N. branch bears N.W. to Surprise Valley, Calif. S. branch bears S.W. to Virgin Ranch.
- 161.40 Ravine course W. ascend to
- 166.00 Ridge bears E. and W.
- 176.00 Ridge bears E. and W.
- 180.00 Ridge bears E. and W.
- 191.60 Ascend steep rocky slope and cliffs 100ft.
- 196.30 Summit of cliffs.
- 197.80 Right bank of Thousand Creek canyon, 200 ft. deep.
- 200.00 Thousand Creek and Canyon, 10 lks. wide, course N.E.
- 200.20 Intersect 9th St. Par. N., at 17.58 chs. E. from Standard Cor. of secs. 33 and 34, R. 26 E., which is a trap rock, 16x12x5 ins., almost obliterated, marked and
