

Subdivisions of T. 17 N., R. 43 E.

Chains N. Co 2' W. on a random line bet. secs. 3 and 4.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.10 Intersect the N. bdy. of tp. 2.80 chs. N. 89o 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W. from the cor. previously established for the cor. of secs. 3,4,33 and 34., which cor. I change to refer to cor. of secs. 33 and 34 of T. 18 N. R.43 E.

At point of intersection with N. bdy. I set a granite stone, 18x12x8 ins. 12 ins in the ground , for the cor. to secs. 3 and 4 , marked C.C. on the S. face , with 3 groves on the E and 3 groves on the W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high S. of cor. Pits impracticable.

Thence I run,

S. Co 2' E. on a true line, bet. secs. 3 and 4.

39.10 Set slate stone 18x10x8 ins. 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft, high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

42.60 Summit, bears E. and W.

53. 40 Ravine, course NW.

79.10 The cor. of secs. 3 and 16.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, stony . 2nd. and 3rd. rate.

Timber, Pine , cedar, mahogany and sagebrush.

Mountainous land, 79.10 chains.
