

Resurvey of Boundary of T. 14 N., R. 41 E.

Chains	
	From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, already described, I retrace the line bet. secs 1 and 36 on the N. bdy. of T.14 N. R. 41 E. I find the line bears N. 89° 25' W. and is 79.10 chs. in length. I reestablish in the same place the cor. to secs. 1, 6, 31 and 36, or the cor. to Tps.14 & 15 N., Rs.41 & 42 E by setting the same stone firmly in the ground and building mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high S. of cor.
	Thence I run
	N. 89° 25' W. bet. secs. 1 and 36.
3.40	Top of cliff, bearing N. and S.,
5.00	Foot of precipice, bears N. and S.,
11.45	Canon, course N., wood road, bears N. and S.,
23.00	Summit, bears N.W.,
25.60	Ravine, course NW.,
39.55	No cor. found, so I establish ¼ sec. cor. being ½ dist. bet. Tp.cor. and cor. of 1, 2, 35 and 36. I set granite stone 16x12x8 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ on N. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high N. of cor.
