

Resurvey of Subdivisions of T. 19 N., R. 44 E.

Chains	Timber, sagebrush Mountainous land, difficult to survey, 80 chs.
	N. 0° 21' E. on E. bdy. of sec. 3.
5.68	The cor. to secs. 2 and 11. A granite stone 17x11x7 ins. re- set at same point, and change marks to 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edge. Dig pits 18x18x12 ins., in each sec. 6 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high E. of cor.
10.10	Ravine, course SE.,
20.95	Ridge, bears E. and W.,
25.85	Ravine, course NE.,
32.60	Enter grass
33.60	Leave grass
40.00	Set a granite stone 22x12x7 ins., 17 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to sec. 3, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face. Dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.
45.68	I was not able to find any trace of the the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. I set a granite stone 14x8x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to sec. 2, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face. Dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of stone 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.
53.90	Ridge, bears E. and W.,
65.40	Ravine, course NE.,
76.00	Ridge, bears E. and W.,
82.67	The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the N. bdy. of T. 19 N., R. 44 E.; mound fallen and scattered. Here I set a granite stone 18x12x10 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, marked with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edge. Dig pits 18x18x12 ins., in ea. sec. $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor.
