Set quartzite stone 24x10x8 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked S C  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face: dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of stone 3 ft. dist.: raise mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high N. of cor.

Intersect the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, a post in bad state of preservation which I destroy and establish at the same point as follows:-

Set a quartz stone 18x12x 4 ins. 12 ins. in the ground, for standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, marked S C on N. with 1 groove on E. and 5 grooves on W. face, dig pits 24x18x12 ins., crosswise on each line, E. and W. 3 ft. and N. 7 ft., dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high N. of Cor.
