

Retracement of the E. Bdy. of Tp. 35 N., R. 67 E. (9)

Chains:

April 21: At 8h.0m.a.m. l.m.t., I set off 40°56' on the lat. arc., and 11° 48' N. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian at the closing cor. of tps. 35 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E., a stone previously described.

Thence I retrace

South along the E. bdy of sec. 1,

99.03

Pass 4.32 chs. E. of the cor. of secs. 1 and 12. The dist. bet. these two cors. is therefore 99.15 chs. and the course S. 2°30' W.

From this cor. I run S. making careful search for cors. at every 40 and 80 chs., finding none until

Pass 7.12 chs. E. of the cor. of tps. 34 and 35 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E. The dist. bet. these cor. is therefore 401.63 chs. and the course S. 1°1' W.--April 21:

~~This cor. being a post in bad state of preservation I destroy and replace with a new cor. at the same point as follows:-~~

~~Set a lime stone 22x10x6 ins., 16 ins. in the ground for cor. of tps. 34 and 35 N., R. 67 E., on the W.bdy. Tp. 34 N., R. 68 E., marked with 6 notches on N. S. and W. edges: and raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. Pits impracticable.~~

~~From the above described Tp. cor. I run N. 1°1' E., on the E. line Sec. 36.~~

~~Through scattering pine and cedar timber, ascending mts. land~~

~~Spur, bears N. 45° E., and S. 45° W., descend~~

~~Spur, bears E. and W., descend~~
