Set a lime stone 20x12x8 ins., 15 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, marked C C on S., with 1 groove on E. and 5 grooves on W. face: dig pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise of each line, E. and W., 3 ft. dist. and S. 7 ft. dist. and raise mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high S. of cor.
