99.22 Intersect the 5th. Standard Parallel North at  $N89^{\circ}58'W, 79$  lks. from the standard cor. to secs. 32 and 33, re-established by me July 23, 1909.

Set a limestone  $12/12/4$  ins., 8 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, marked C C on S. and with 5 grooves on E. and 1 groove on W. face; dig pits  $24/18/12$  ins. crosswise on each line, E. and W. 3ft., and S. of stone 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high S. of cor.

Land slopes to the N.W.

Soil, gravelly loam. 1 st. rate.

Sagebrush. No timber.
