

Resurvey of Boundary of T. 28 N. E. 51 E.

Chains.

- 72.00 Draw, course S.
- 74.50 End of flat ridge, bears N. and S.
- 80.00 After a diligent search no signs of the old cor. are found. I set a pine post 3 ft long, 4 ins square, with marked stone, 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs 5.6.31 and 32, marked T28 N S 32 on NE., R 51 E S5 on SE., T 27 N S6 on SW. and S 31 on the NW. face with 5 notches on the E. and 1 notch on the W. edge; dig pits 18x18x12 ins. in each sec. 5½ ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base 2 ft. high W of cor. Land rolling.
Soil, sandy loam 1st and 2nd. rate.
Timber, sagebrush.
Rolling land 80.00 chains.
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- N 89° 56' W. bet, secs 31 and 6.
- 4.80 ~~Creek~~ Creek bed, course SE.
- 5.00 Ascend
- 12.00 Nose of ridge, bears N. and S.
- 20.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.
- 22.00 Steep descent to here.
- 23.00 Dry creek, course SE.
- 40.00 After a diligent search, no signs of the old ¼ sec. cor are found. I set a pine post 3 ft. long 3 ins. square, with marked stone, 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S 31 on N. and 6 on the S. face; dig pits 18x18x12 ins E. and W. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 3½ ft. base 1½ ft high N. of cor.
- 46.00 Tableland, flat.
- 57.50 ~~Desc~~ Descend to canon.
- 63.50 Creek bed, course SE.
- 77.90 The old cor. of Tps. 27 and 28 N. R's 50 and 51 E. Which is a cedar stake almost decayed, in an earth mound. I destroy all traces of the old cor. and the same place
