

Subdivisions of T. 28 N. R. 51 E.

Chains.

Over level valley for 3.00 chains.

3.00 Start ascent to small hump.

12.00 Draw, course E. Enter Juniper timber.

13.00 Summit of ridge, bears E. and W.

20.00 Wash, course E.

24.00 Ridge, bears E&W.

27.55 Road, Pine valley to Little Pole creek, bears NW.&SE.

28.00 Creek bed, course E.

37.50 Ridge, bears E& W. Leave timber.

38.00 Level land.

40.00 Set a limestone 24x14x6 ins. 18 ins in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft high W. of cor. Pits impracticable

48.00 Ascend.

51.00 Ridge, bears NE&SW.

54.50 Nose of ridge, bears E&W.

58.00 Valley floor.

59.50 Creek bed, course NE.

65.10 Creek bed, course SE, Ascend.

68.00 Over rolling hills.

75.22 Intersect N. bdy. 4.20 chains E of the cor. of secs. 35 and 36. of T. 28 N. R. 51 E. I set a limestone 20x12x4 ins. 15 ins in the ground for the closing cor of secs. 1 and 2, marked CC on the S with 1 groove on the E. and 5 grooves on the W. face, from which a cedar 12 ins. dia. bears S.54oE. 49 lks dist. marked T. 28 N. R 51 E S I B T.

A cedar 8 ins in dia. bears S.33o 30' W. 201 lks. dist. marked t 28 N R 51 E S2 B T.

Land, rolling

Soil, sandy, second rate.

Timber, cedar and sagebrush.

Rolling land 75.22 chs.
