Chains.

Land. rolling.

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N, 0o 2' W. on a true line bet. secs. 3 and 4.

15.00 Proceed up valley to

Creek bed, course SE.

Ascend diagonally on slope.

24.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.

26.00 Slight ravine course N.W.

35.00 Ridge, bears, ~~N.W.~~ and SE.

39.00 Ravine, course SE.

40.00 Set an andesite stone 14x10x6 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high. W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

41.00 Tableland.

60.00 Creek bed, course SE.

70.00 Tableland again.

74.30 Road, Little Pole creek to Pine valley, bears, SE. & NW.

75.20 Intersect N. bdy. 4.20 chains E of the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, of T. 29 N. R 51 E. Set an andesite stone 14x8x6 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for closing cor of secs. 3 and 4, marked ~~CC~~ with 3 grooves on the E. and W. faces, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high. S of cor. Pits impracticable.
