Chains.	Aug. 26th 1909.
	At 7h 15 m. A.M.l.m.t. I set off 100 33' N on the decl arc and 400 18' on the lat arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. Thence I run West on a true line bet. secs 7 and 18.
8.30	Cliffs extending E. and W. on mountain side.
20.29	Spur, bears NW. and SE.
24.49	Main canon. course N.
26.00	Ascend Steep mountain.
36.19	Spur, bears NE. and SW.
40.00	Set a rhyolite stone, 20x10x6 ins, 15 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft, base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft, high N. of cor. Pits impracticable.
42,34	Nose of ridge, bears NW. and SE.
44.44	Draw, course NE.
46.71	Nose, bears NE. and SW.
47.46	Draw, course NE.
62.98	Spur, bears NE. and SW.
77.94	Intersect E. bdy of T.28 N. R 49 E. 2.14 chs. S 00 7' W. from the cor. of secs 1, and 12. I set a rhyolite stone 20x10x8 ins 15 ins in the ground for closing cor. of secs 7 and 18. marked CC on E, with 2 grooves on the N, and 4 grooves on the S. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft, high E. of cor. Pits impracticable.
